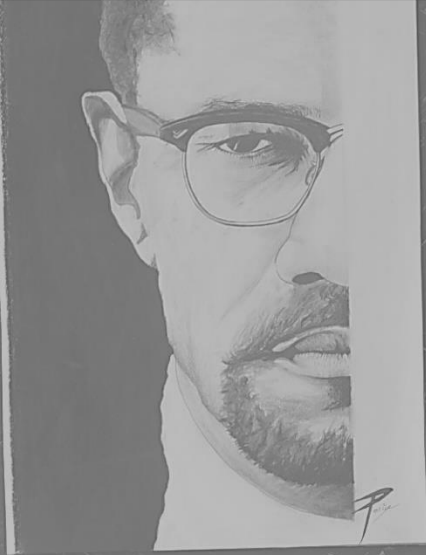

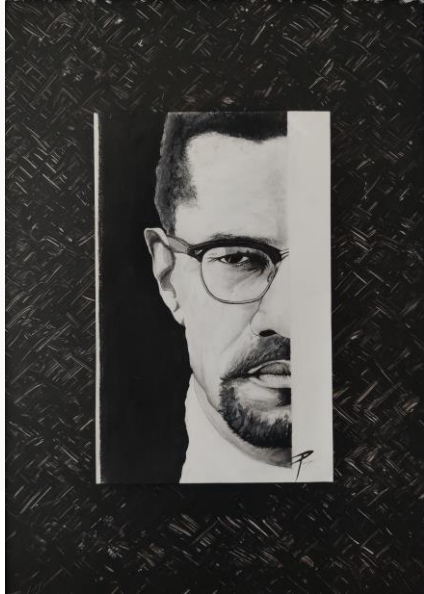

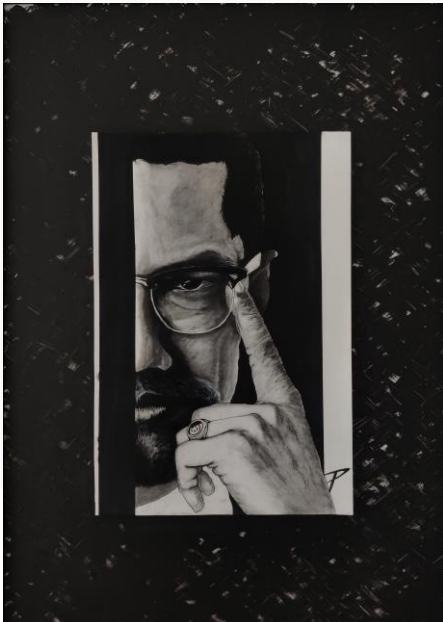

"RESOLVE is the 1st of two primarily charcoal based paintings I have done of the enigmatic Malcolm X.

Malcolm X was an activist who fought against oppression of Black Americans and championed the cause of Uniting all Black people globally in his later years.

He was very passionate about the cause of uniting the Black Nation globally and can be attributed with having succeeded in this before his untimely assassination in 1963. He is known to have approached all issues and problems the same... with an intense and unwavering RESOLVE (!)

I have done this work in one of my unique styles mixing several media that are not normally mixed by most artists.

"BY ANY MEANS NECESSARY is the 2nd of two primarily charcoal based paintings I have done of the enigmatic Malcolm X.

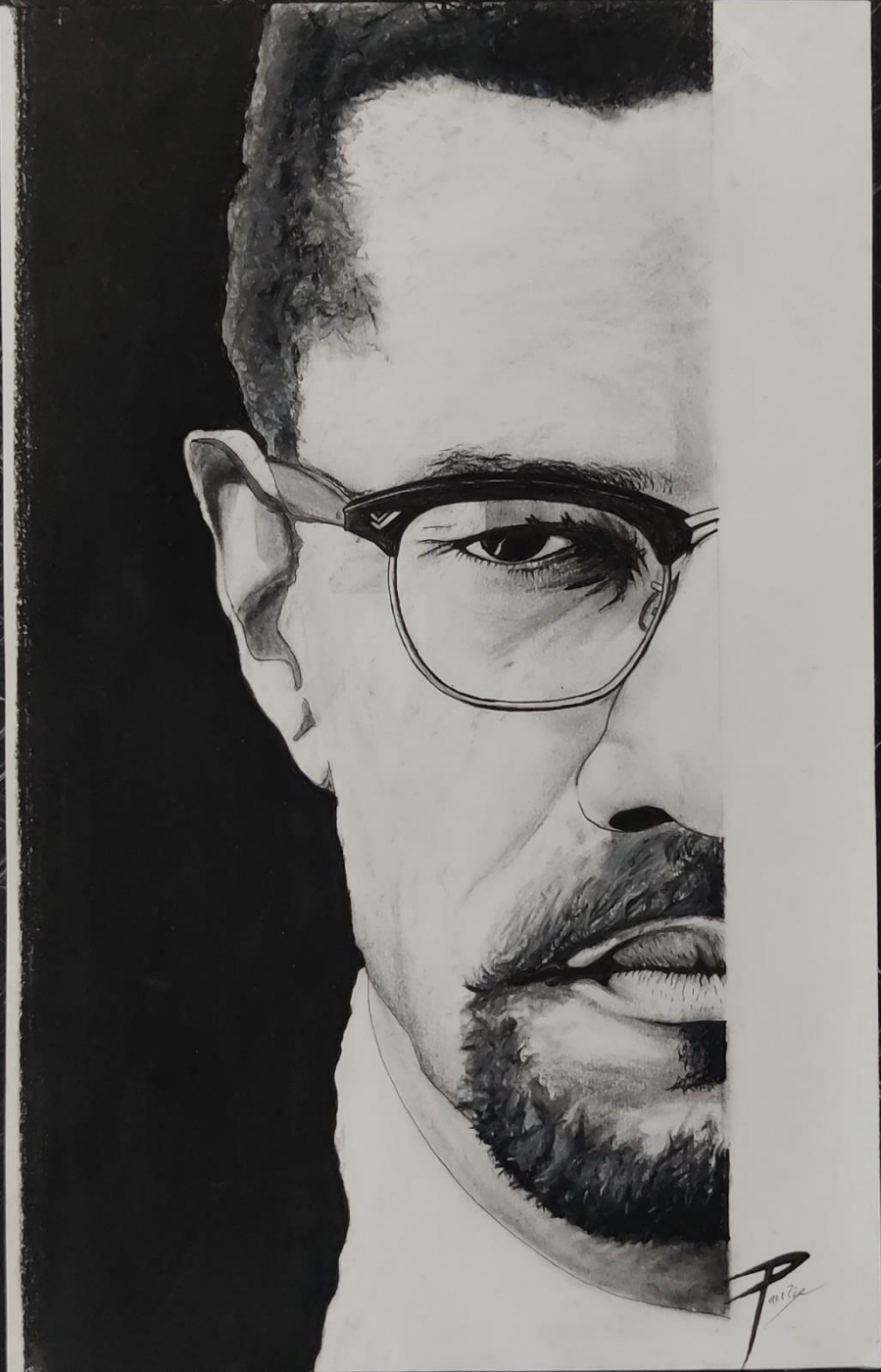
Malcolm X was an activist who fought against oppression of Black Americans and championed the cause of Uniting all Black people globally in his later years.

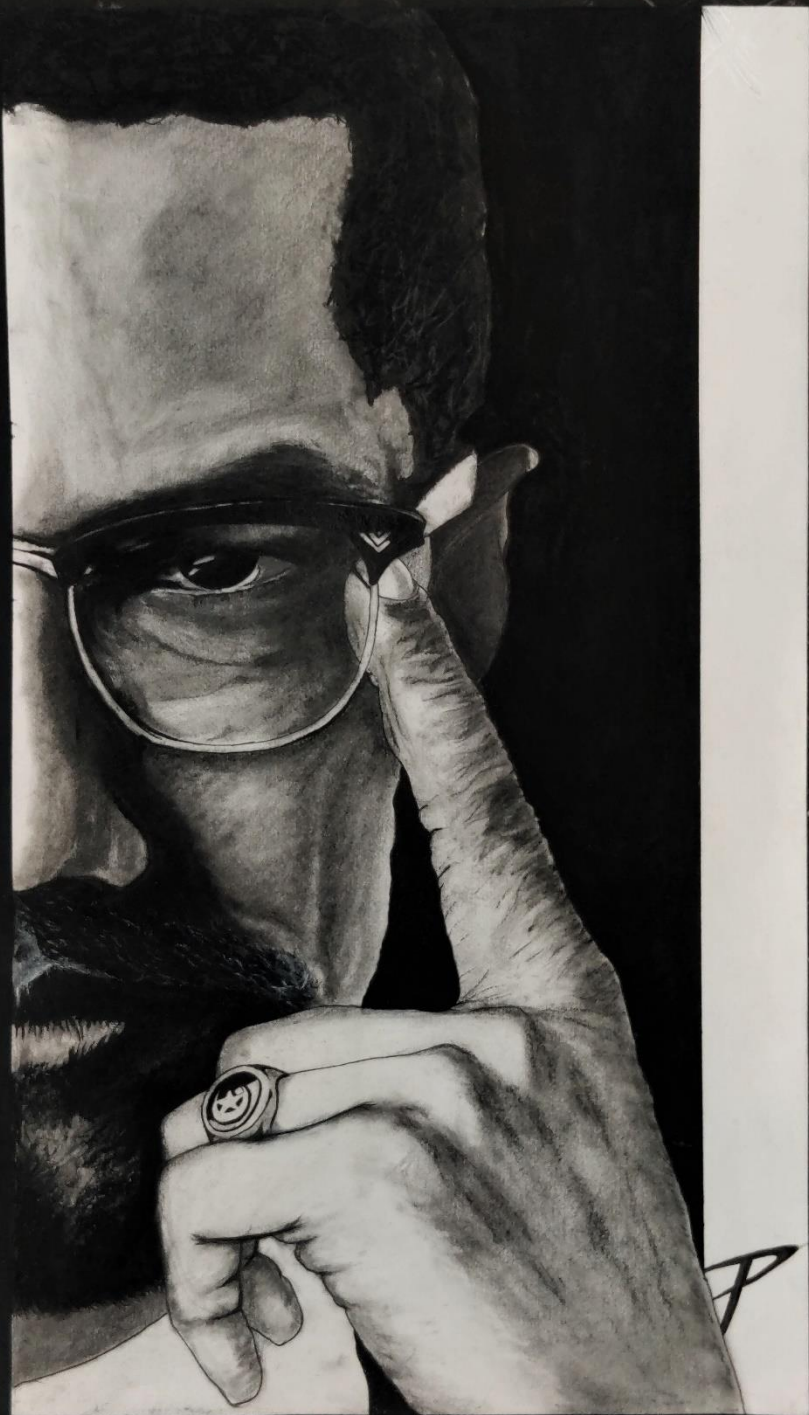
While highly influential and eloquent, he was also militant. Controversial...

The X's painted into the background pattern are deeply symbolic of the movement Malcolm X started. A movement centred around recognising and owning your self worth again!

I injured myself pretty badly just after Christmas 2021. I translated that pain I was feeling, and seeing in three distinct colours, into this exquisite and masterful work of art, (yeah, I know, I'm not shy about saying I've created something stunning)!

"This piece was born from a place of chaos... hope from chaos... choosing to see the order in the chaos. I was in a place in my life where there were quite a lot of unknowns... potentially good or bad... lots of decisions to make..

The proverbial "'fork in the road'". Choose one path or choose another. No going back!

In a not so rare moment of synaesthesia, my feelings formed into colours I could see very clearly in my mind... clear but also without form.. roiling, in turmoil... deep in my chest.

I used a painterly technique for this piece, allowing the different hues of acrylic to morph and shape while intermixing with each other but not too much. It is rough. It is visceral. But also somewhat ordered. Cyclonic. Like a Vortex. Somewhat mathematically predictable. Order in Chaos!

I had more or less painted the void, the black hole that is the unknown or set of unknowns that were troubling me in my very near future.

All conglomerating at the centre of the piece in the middle of the swirl... the void.

"This piece is the visual antonym of INTO THE VOID. They serve as a diptych piece balancing out the Yin and Yang of my tumultuous emotional swing within the space of 7 days!

I painted this in a similar synaesthesia-induced state to its sister painting.

The motivation was simple... I was in a deep state of artistic FLOW. This painting ...FLOW is the physical manifestation of exactly how I felt.

Exactly 7 days after I felt like I was going INTO THE VOID.

Personally, this painting was also a celebration of the culmination my collaboration with Monat Gallery, Madrid.

It is a 'happy painting'.

This exploration of flow is a happy expression of beauty, freedom and self-acceptance... acceptance that whatever path I am on right now is the right one.

It is meant to evoke the feeling of "relaxed" but "not backing down".

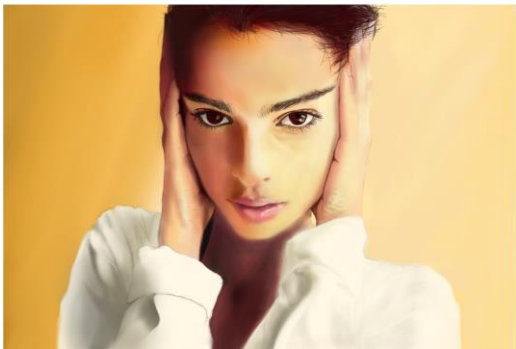

The art series, 'X_Faces, Find X', is a feminist focussed series by London based artist Paulie X portraying strong beautiful women. Mostly with expressionless faces.

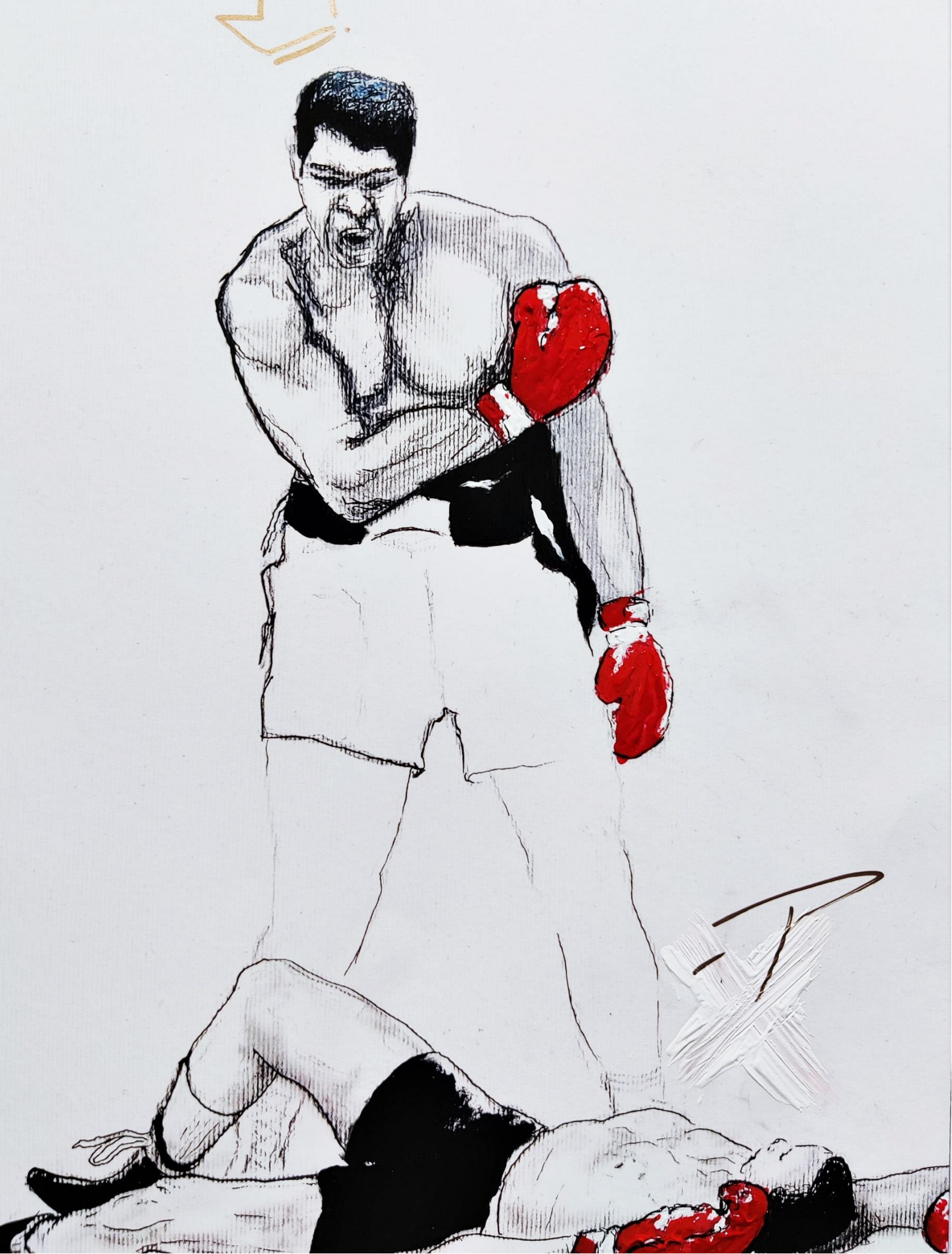
The viewer is challenged by the bold stare of the subject... Confident,... Firm... not backing down.

King ALI

""King ALI"" is the 7th Mixed Media painting by _Paulie__ X in the 'Black Kings' Art Series.

Depicted in this painting, is Boxing Legend - Muhammad Ali, as he defeated Sonny Liston for the 2nd time in May 1965 to retain his world heavy weight boxing champion title, in a highly charged rematch after defeating Sonny Liston in a major upset in February 1964 to win the World Heavy Weight title.

Stylistically, I have chosen to leave most of it especially on Ali 'scribbly', with visible sketch lines in pencil and ink adding to the effect of raw passion and unbridled emotion captured in the image.

Charcoal and Acrylic highlights have been used for a high contrast, layered, painterly effect to give the image a rich depth and juxtapose a balance between the defeated Liston lying on the canvas, and the powerful, victorious KING ALI, remonstrating over his once again defeated opponent.

Political Activist, Academic, Feminist, Accomplished Author, Black Female Icon. Professor emerita of the University of California.

Long-time fighter for rights, justice, equality, and anti-racist campaigner as well as campaigned for prison reform in America.

I find her such an empowering and intriguing figure and when an artist friend suggested her as my next subject, it was an immediate ""Yes, ANGELA!!!"



Stylistically, I went for what's becoming my more iconic mixed media artistic style of late mixing a bit of everything in this piece --- charcoal, pencils, ink, newspaper cut-outs even! ...and embellished with gold and silver acrylic highlights!

The Red acrylic really brings Angela to life, and symbolizes the blood... spilled blood of so many black people of more than 400 years of slavery and oppression, a plight which sadly in 2020, is still an ongoing struggle with the wanton killings of innocent black people like Breonna Taylor, George Floyd and the paralysis of Jacob Blake more recently.

The struggle continues.... I use my art as a means to get people talking, keep awareness up.

Artivism has always been with us. Artivism will always be with us."

"ROYALTY -- and the symbolism thereof; what better way to capture the essence of what that means than a crown.

The Gold crown is set against a dark, black background, completely absorbing and surrounding the ornate headpiece, but also highlighting it even more.

BLACK

'Royalty' --- as an ode to the past, explores the many forgotten crowns of blackness, lost in blackness.

Kings, Queens, Princes, Princesses of Kingdoms and Queendoms long lost and forgotten, pillaged and impoverished due to the unfortunate influences of slavery and colonialism over centuries.

'Royalty' --- as a love letter for the now... as hope for the future, is the crown-piece of Paulie's Art series 'Black Kings', and celebrates the many Black Men and Women shining their lightds brighter, no matter what.
